## WE OFFER ADI INSTRUCTORS

**Flexibility**: join us on an event-by-event basis for a part or a full day - there is no ongoing contract or commitment.

**You choose how often**: currently a maximum of one full day at a driving event approx. every 2 months from February to November, the absolute minimum would be one part day at an event sometime during 2024 - you agree to attend when it suits you, and you don't when it doesn't.

**Part or full day rate**: we commit to paying the full amount for each event you agree to attend - even if we don't have a full diary of learners for you that day.

**Bonuses**: something extra for those who eg. attend 5 events in a row, introduce another Instructor who becomes a regular team member, or who receives a really good testimonial from a learner.

**No prep**: a day in the car without having to schedule learners, chase payments, deal with cancellations, think about lesson planning or focus on test prep - we do all the admin, you just 'arrive and drive'.

**Free promo**: for you and / or your driving school - spend time with young learners and parents who will probably be looking for on-road lessons in the not-too-distant future.

**Time to chat**: with other Instructors between learner sessions, and also at social get-togethers held at the end of each event - being an Instructor means working solo most of the time, but at our under 17 events that's different.

**Join our ADI and PDI team**: a group of Instructors you can ask questions to if you need a bit of support, or share your knowledge if someone is struggling with something you can help with.

## **WE OFFER LEARNERS**

We organise under 17 driving event days for younger learners age 14+

- We focus on developing driving skills while having fun, at private venues in the Warks area away from public roads and everyday traffic.
- We have various activity areas so learners are developing their skills as they drive around, inc. our figure-of-eight and slalom areas, and with an early introduction to manoeuvres including bay and parallel parking.
- We provide safe driving experiences for younger learners, with DVSA registered ADIs and PDIs in dual controlled cars.

We have 2 main types of under 17 learners

- 16 year olds preparing for on-road driving lessons at 17+, who may choose to stay with the Instructor they have got to know through us.
- 14, 15 and 16 year olds who join us as part of their birthday celebrations.

Sessions for learners last from 30 minutes, up to a maximum of 90 minutes.

Our driving events are currently held around every 2 months from February to November, and usually at weekends.
